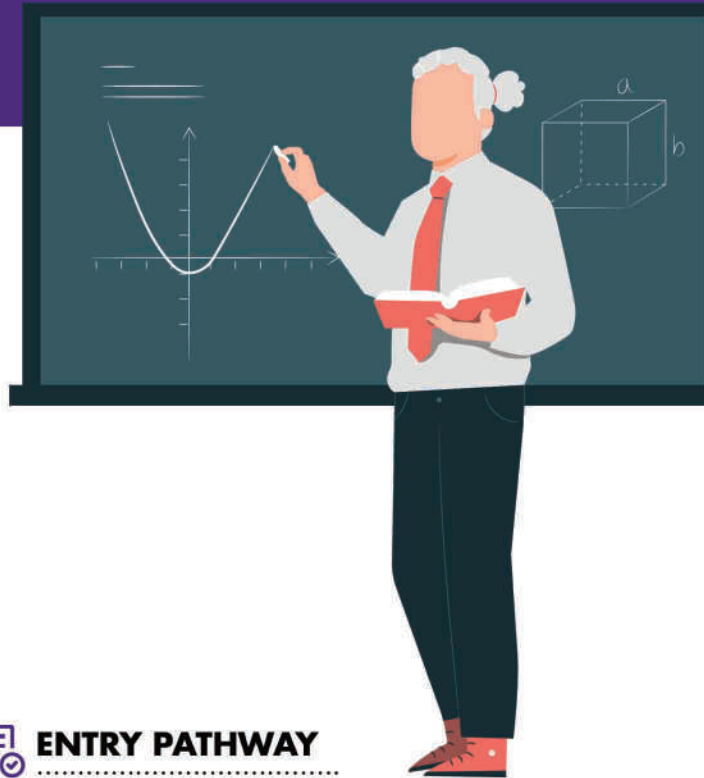

ENTRY PATHWAY

1. Complete 10 + 2 in any stream
2. Complete Bachelor's degree in a subject of your choice, followed by Master's degree in the same subject
3. Qualify in the relevant competitive exam such as UGC NET (National Eligibility Test)/GATE (Graduate Aptitude Test in Engineering)/SLET (State Level Eligibility Test)
4. After clearing the exam and receiving the relevant certificate, apply for the profile of Assistant Professor in reputed Indian colleges and universities across the country
