Introduction

Assam is a state with diversified cultures comprising a multi-ethnic society. The Scheduled Caste (SC) population forms 7.15% while the Scheduled Tribe (ST) population contributes to 12.45% of the total population of the State (Census 2011). Varied geopolitical dynamics further distinguishes the landmass of the state into distinct expanses like the char areas, tea intensive districts, conflict prone areas, flood prone districts etc. These unique characteristics also have a bearing on the overall progress in children education across the state.

Social protection deems the reduction of vulnerability, well-being and development of its citizens as the responsibility of the state. Both central as well as state government has a range of social protection schemes for targeted vulnerable populations as well as entitlements which deem citizens as not mere beneficiaries but as having legitimate rights, addressing needs of all citizens. To support marginalized children education, health and their rights, Central as well as State Government are sponsoring a number of schemes and scholarships at various levels.

The hand book aims to map the existing schemes, sponsorships and their entitlements at national as well as state level and provide information to students, parents, teachers and other stakeholders. It is expected to be of useful especially for the students and teachers to know about the range of schemes, their entitlements that they are eligible for by virtue of being citizens of the State of Assam and India. RIGHT OF CHILDREN TO FREE & COMPULSORY EDUCATION ACT, 2009(RTE)

Objective of Scheme

To entitle every child between the age of 6 to 14 years with the right to free and compulsory elementary Education (up to standard 8th)

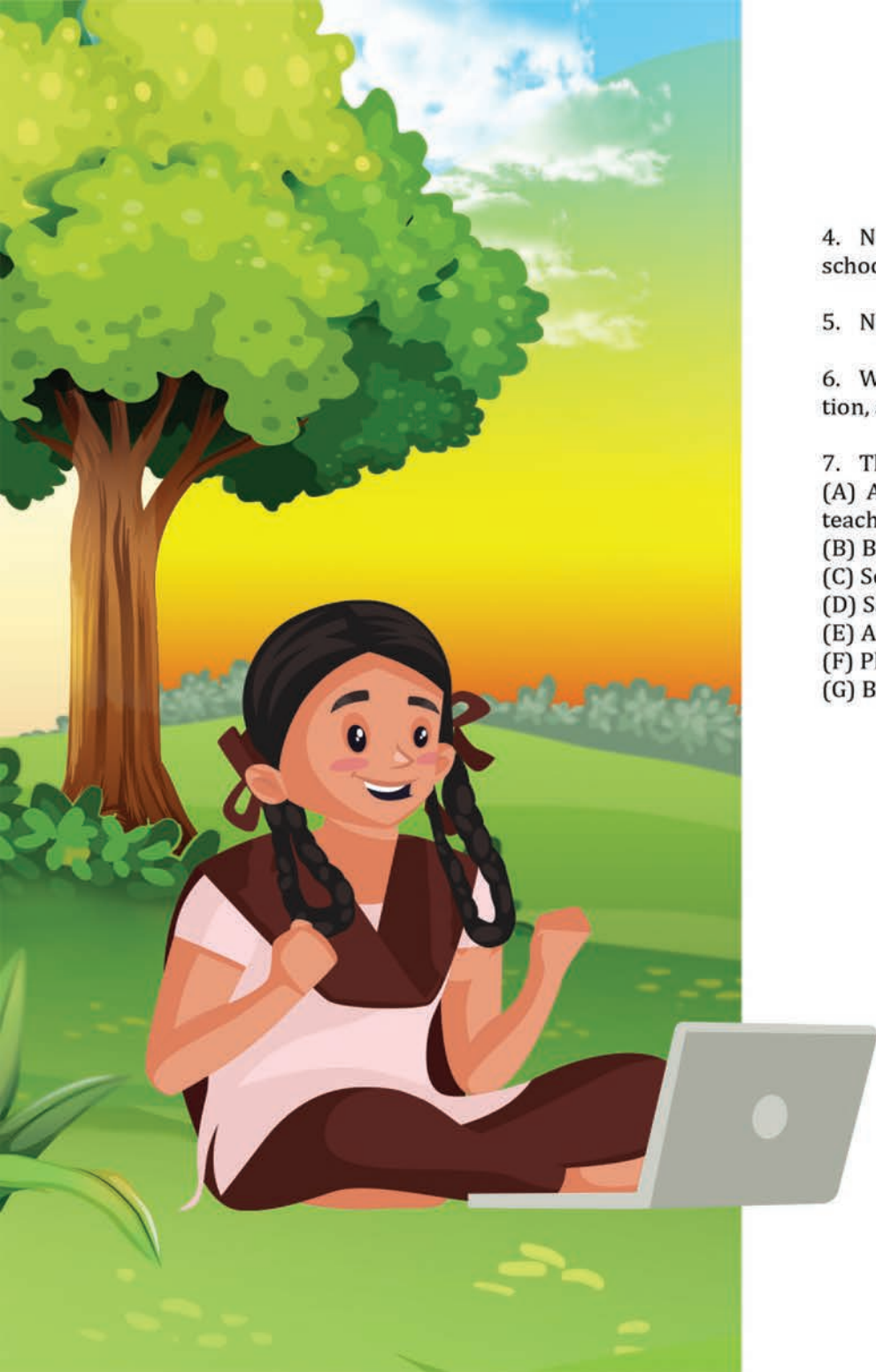
Target Beneficiaries

All children from 6 to 14 years of age

Provisions under scheme / entitlements

1. Every child of the age of six to fourteen years, including a child with disability shall have the right to free and compulsory education in a neighbourhood school till the completion of his or her elementary education (first to eight class)
2. Where a child above six years of age has not been admitted in any school or though admitted, could not complete his or her elementary education, then, he or she shall be admitted in a class appropriate to his or her age, provided he or she shall, in order to be at par with others, have a right to receive special training
3. No school or person shall, while admitting a child, collect any capitation fee and subject the child or his or her parents or guardian to any screening procedure





Provisions under scheme / entitlements

4. No child admitted in a school shall be held back in any class or expelled from school till the completion of elementary education
5. No child shall be subjected to physical punishment or mental harassment
6. Where in a school, there is no provision for completion of elementary education, a child shall have a right to seek transfer to any other school
7. The school building would be an all-weather building consisting of:
 - (A) At least one class room for every teacher and an office-cum-store-Head teacher's room
 - (B) Barrier free access
 - (C) Separate toilets for boys & girls
 - (D) Safe and adequate DW for all children
 - (E) A kitchen where MDM would be cooked in school
 - (F) Playground
 - (G) Boundary wall/fencing

PM POSHAN (formerly Mid-Day-Meal Scheme)

Objective of Scheme

- The objectives of the mid-day meal scheme are:
- Improving the nutritional status of children in classes I – VIII in Government, Local Body and Government aided schools, and EGS and AIE centres
 - Encouraging poor children, belonging to disadvantaged sections, to attend school more regularly and help them concentrate on classroom activities
 - Providing nutritional support to children of primary stage in drought-affected areas during summer vacation

Target Beneficiaries

All school going children upto 14 years of age are to be provided MDM





Provisions under scheme / entitlements

Every child within the age group of six to fourteen years studying in classes I to VIII who enroll and attend the school, shall be provided hot cooked meal having nutritional standards of 450 calories and 12 gm of protein for primary and 700 calories and 20 gm protein for upper primary free of charge every day except on school holidays. The place of serving meals to the children shall be school only

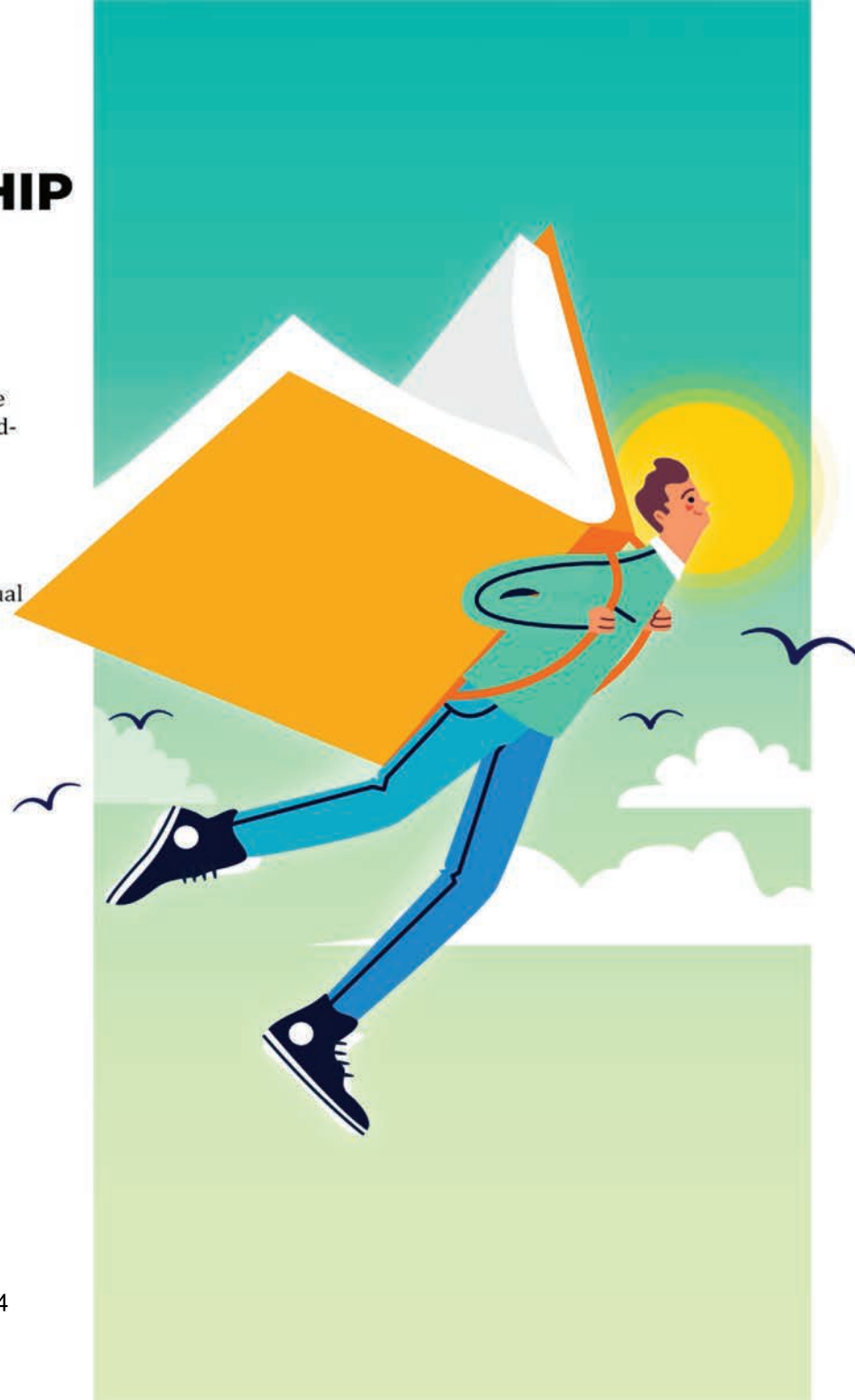

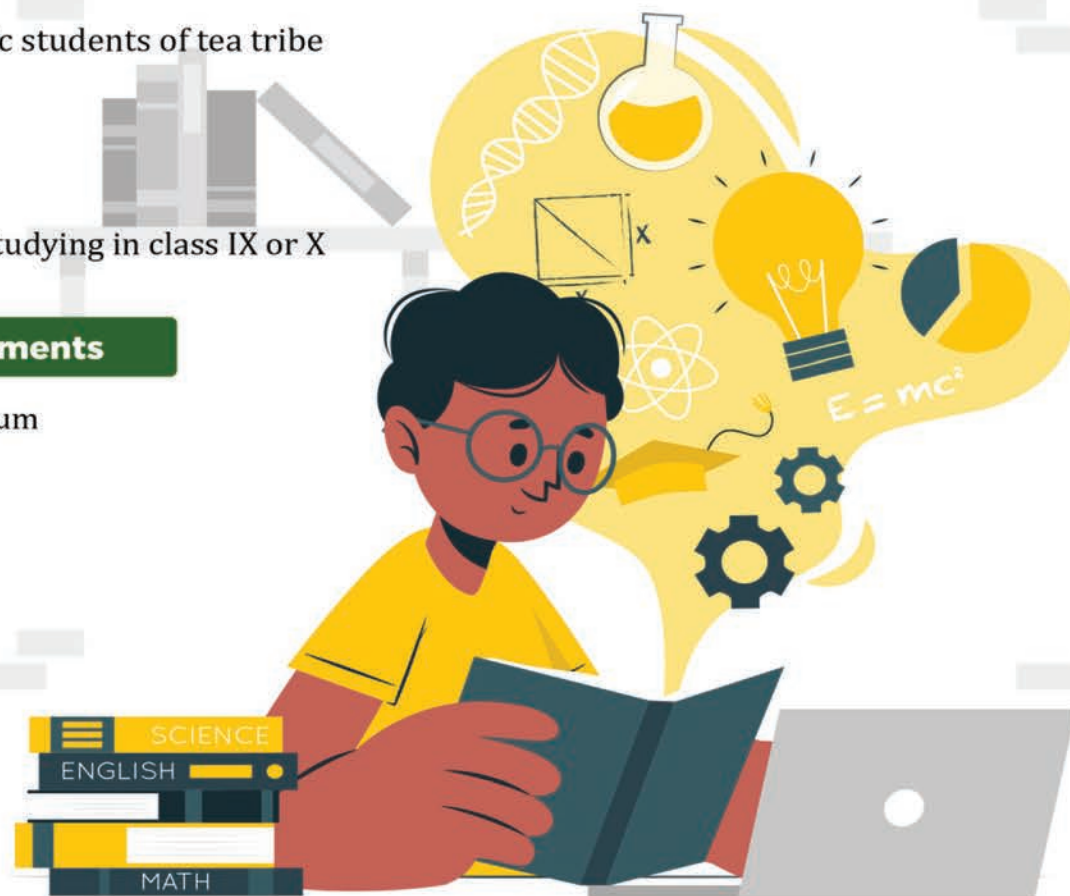

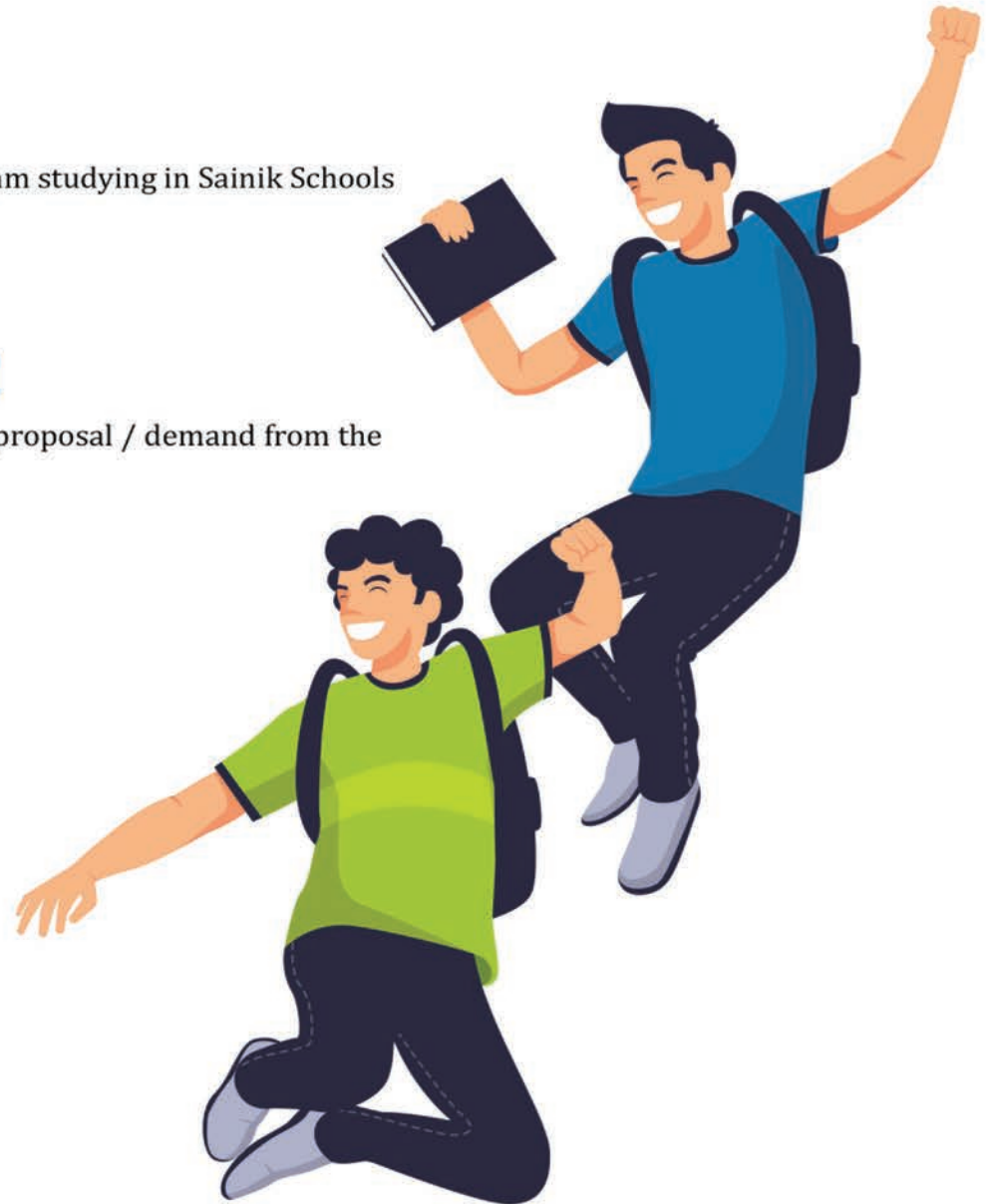
