ENTRY PATHWAY

1. Complete 10+2 in any stream
2. Complete Bachelor's degree (LLB) and then clear the All India Judicial Service
OR
Complete Bachelor's degree followed by a Master's degree (LLM) and then clear the All India Judicial Service / Assam Judicial Service Examination
3. For admissions into Law colleges, you must qualify entrance exams such as CLAT, AILET, CUET, LSAT, MH CET Law, TS LAW CET, AP LAW CET, DU LLB, PU LLB, SLS AIAT
