## ENTRY PATHWAY

Currently no college in India offers L.L.B. in Sports Law. There are, however, a handful of colleges, which offer L.L.M. in this area.

1. Complete 10+2 in any stream
2. Pursue a 5-year L.L.B. course and then either apply for L.L.M. or PGDM in Sports Law
3. If you choose to pursue L.L.M. in Sports Law abroad, you will need to take English Language Tests such as IELTS or TOEFL

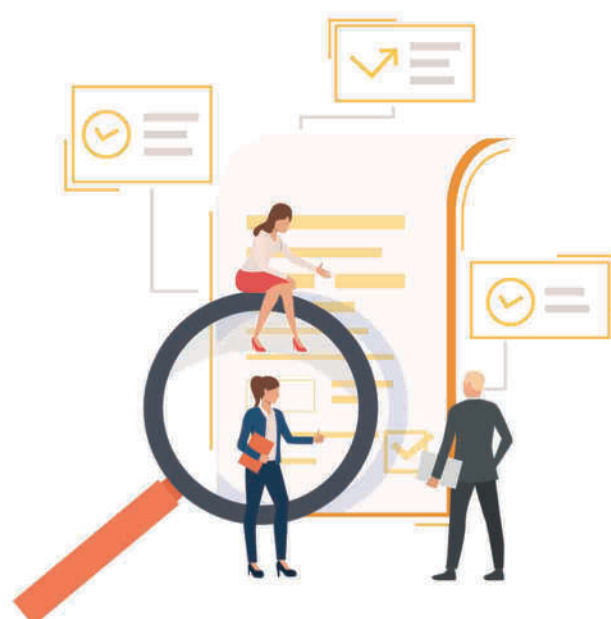
