Places of Work: Hospitals, Medical clinics, Rehabilitation centres, College and universities, and Professional sports organizations.

Work Environment: You are likely to work with a particular athletic team or a university sports team or a fitness club. You are also likely to work in a team, as you may need to consult with the trainers and coaches. If you are working with a team, their work hours will determine your work hour. If you are part of a university team or fitness club then you are likely to work 5 to 6 days a week and 8 to 9 hours a day.
