Inclusive education is no longer a privilege; it is the need of the hour. For a developing country like India, education is the topmost aspect of growth. NEP recognizes the importance of creating enabling mechanisms for providing Children With Special Needs (CWSN) or Divyang, the same opportunities of obtaining quality education as any other child. Children with disabilities will be enabled to fully participate in the regular schooling process from the Foundational Stage to higher education.

The Integrated Scheme on School Education aims to look at education of all children, including Children with Special Needs (CWSN), in a continuum from pre nursery to Class XII. The scheme covers all children with special needs with one or more disabilities as mentioned in the schedule of disabilities of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities (RPwD) Act, 2016 studying in Government, Government-aided and local body schools. The goal of the Inclusive Education is to reduce the gap in the enrolment, retention, completion rates and achievement of children with respect to gender and socially advantaged groups. The inclusion of CWSN has to be seen in terms of physical access, social access and quality of access.

#### **Target Group/beneficiary of the scheme**

Target Group of the Scheme are the Children with special needs in the age group of 6-18 yrs. The scheme covers all children from pre nursery to senior secondary stage studying in Government, local body and government-aided schools, with one or more disabilities as defined under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act (2016) namely:
