World Disabled Day is observed every year on 3 December around the world to promote an awareness on disability issues and the fundamental rights of persons with disabilities. This year it was planned to organize a week long programme - "Pratibandhi Saptah" from 28th November to 3rd December ,2016 on the eve of World Disabled Day .

Guidelines for Observation of "Pratibandhi Saptah" (28th November – 3rd December,2016)

1. Pratibandhi Saptah should be observed from 28th Nov to 3rd December 2016.
2. Every School will celebrate the day as per the academic calendar
3. CRCC/Block Acct./DQM and all IE functionaries of the concerned block will visit each school having CWSN during the" Pratibandhi Saptah"
4. DPOs may be assigned block wise responsibility and attend the programme on 3rd December,2016

School level activities

- a) Awareness among the children on disability.
- b) Sharing success stories of famous disabled person among the children.
- c) Peer group sensitization.
- d) Involvement of Parents, Teacher, SMC members and all school functionaries.
- e) Plantation may be done in the school campus.
- f) Invitation of local successful person with disability.
- g) Awareness on SSA activities under Inclusive Education component.
- h) 100% enrollment of out of school CWSN and their retention in school.
- i) School may organize inclusive cultural activities among the students including CWSN.
- j) Discussion on classroom management and evaluation.
- k) Local authority should be involved in the programme.
